# Map of Vietnam




Vietnam is highlighted in red on the map.

#### **Culture & Traditions**

#### **Festivals**

Tet, meaning 'festival of the first day' is the lunar New Year and the biggest festival in Vietnam. It is a celebration of renewal and hope and the majority of Vietnam closes for a week to honour it.



#### Martial arts.

The vietnamese martial arts tradition was born of constant need for defence against foreign invaders. It was heavily influenced by China during its ongoing occupation, but over time the vietnamese developed their distinct styles. 'Vovinam' was founded in Hanoi and can be recognised by the blue uniforms they wear. It is most famous for its scissor kick, used to dismount attackers on horseback. 'Vo Binh Dinh' wear distinct black uniforms and owe their reputation to the legendary warrior king, Quang Trung.

# Vietnamese currency.

The dong has been the currency in Vietnam since May 3, 1978. 1 Vietnamese dong equals 0.000036 Euro.



# Vietnamese war. (1955-1975)

The Vietnam war pitted communist North Vietnam and the Viet Cong against South Vietnam and the USA. The war ended when U.S. forces withdrew in 1973 and Vietnam unified under Communist control two years later. The war lasted 19 years. Some 365,000 Vietnamese civilians are estimated to have died as a result of the war during the period of american involvement.
